# 3 Days 2 Nights Private Discovery in Bai Tu Long Bay

## DAY 1: HALONG - BAI TU LONG BAY (L/D)

- **12:00** Arrival to **Bhaya Cruise Center** at Tuan Chau International Marina.
- **12:30** Board your Bhaya Legend and meet your crew. Enjoy a refreshing welcome drink followed by a cruise safety briefing presented by your private butler.
- **13:00** *Lunch* is served onboard. Enjoy the local fare while Bhaya Legend sails towards the southeast of Halong Bay, passing Fighting-cock Islet, Titop Islet.
- **16:00** Explore **Cong Do area** by *kayak*. With an area of 23,363 km2 and a 172m high mountain, Cong Do area is famous for its natural and pristine beauty.
- **17:30** Return to the boat and freshen up. This is the perfect time to sip some cocktails and immerse in the glorious sunset of Halong Bay.
- **19:15** Dine over candlelight with a sumptuous *set-dinner* in the dining room.
- **21:00** Retire to your cabin for an early night or join our crew for squid fishing.

### DAY 2: BAI TU LONG BAY (B/L/D)

- **06:15** Rise with the sun and welcome the new day with a *Tai Chi lesson*
- **07:30** Enjoy a hearty *breakfast* while the boat starts cruising to the next attraction.
- **09:00** Visit **Cap La Tra San area** by kayak. Far from the mainland, Cap La Tra San Area is isolated from normal tourist routes so the landscape here still retains many primitive features and a very clean environment. Here a lot of coral reefs are concentrated, with underground lakes inside the limestone mountain and underwater caves.
- **11:30** Move to Tra San area and enjoy a special lunch.
- **12:30** Short break for some free time to relax.
- **14:30** Choose to explore the charming **Vung Vieng Fishing Village** by either kayak or rowing boat. You will not only be immersed in the quiet and peaceful location viewing the charming landscape and discovering the cultural life of the fishermen but also will be instructed in the fine arts of sailing and casting fishnets.
- **16:30** Return to Bhaya Legend, just in time to catch the magical sunset while the vessel anchor for the night.
- **17:30** Learn about local cuisine with a *family spirit cooking session* and try your hand at creating authentic Vietnamese dishes.
- **19:15** Delicious *set-dinner* is ready onboard.
- **21:00** Nightfall over the bay. Rest in your cabin or watch the stars while sipping a drink.

### DAY 3: HALONG BAY - BAI TU LONG BAY (B/L/D)

- **08:00** Investigate the centuries-old stalagmites and stalactites of **Thien Canh Son Cave**. Named the theater in the center of the sea, visitors have the opportunity to enjoy the mysterious beauty of gorgeous rosin's system hanging inside the cave. The entire ceiling shine because of being covered with thousands of glittering stalactites, dome wavy create unique images: the stone statues, stone dragons, and flowers are likely to make an ideal world.
- **09:00** Return to the boat and enjoy brunch as the boat cruises leisurely through the limestone karsts towards the harbor.
- **10:30** Say good-bye to your crew and disembark at *Tuan Chau International Marina* with memories fit to last a lifetime of your Gulf of Tonkin journey!
