DAY 1: HALONG – LAN HA BAY (L/D)

11:30	Arrive at Bhaya Cruise Center, located within the Tuan Chau International Marina.
12:00	Board The Au Co and inspect the cabin before heading to the Halong Restaurant for a safety briefing as well as to meet the Cruise Manager and the crew while enjoying a fresh welcome drink.
12:30	Enjoy lunch as the Au Co cruises towards the southeast of Halong Bay, passing Trong Mai Islet, Ngon Tay Islet, Con Coc Islet.
14:30	Ride a bike or hop on an electric cart through Viet Hai village - a peaceful remote enclave within Cat Ba Island. Exploring local life and Bhaya's CSR projects like 'Bhaya Community Farm' and 'Save the Langurs.' Unwind at Bhaya Café, sip a refreshing 'mojitea' or try making 'Bánh Cuốn' a favorite Northern Vietnamese dish.
16:30	Return to the vessel and enjoy swimming in the crystal-clear lagoon where the ship anchors.
17:30	Back to the vessel as it cruises to the anchoring point for the night.
18:00	Marvel at the glorious sunset over enchanting Halong Bay while enjoying the Happy Hour promotion on a selection of drinks.
19:00	Savor the delicious dinner.
21:00	Join a vibrant rice wine tasting session at the restaurant or bar, and discover fascinating facts about Vietnam's most popular rice wines, including local favorites from the Halong region.

17:30	Bar opens for a Happy Hour promotion. Join the exciting cooking on the sundeck (or in the restaurant, depending on the weather). Don't miss out on the stunning view of the sunset over the enchanting Halong Bay from the sundeck of the boat.
19:00	Savor the delicious dinner in the restaurant.
21:30	Unwind and enjoy a peaceful evening, or join our staff on the main deck for some squid fishing. Then, retreat to your cabin for a restful night's sleep.





DAY 3: HALONG BAY - HANOI (B)

- Port authority insists on advance registration including full name, gender, date of birth, nationality, and passport number. At check-in, a valid passport is required. Port authorities may deny boarding if these conditions are not met.
- Free Wifi available on the terrace deck, but note that the internet signal at sea suffers frequent interruption.
- Join us in protecting the environment and saying NO to plastic waste. Bhaya Cruises offers free filtered water in the restaurant area, where guests can refill their personal water bottles during the journey. Amenity kits (toothbrushes and cotton swabs) are available in the reception area. We encourage passengers to prepare their own personal belongings when traveling.
