4 Days 3 Nights In-depth Halong Bay Discovery

DAY 1: HANOI – HALONG BAY (L/D)

- **12:30** Arrival at *Bhaya Cruise Centre.* Meet your cruise manager and embark on your Bhaya Legend boat for a welcome drink followed by a cruise safety briefing.
- **13:00 Lunch** is served. Enjoy local fare while Bhaya Legend sails through Halong Bay towards Cua Van area.
- **15:30** Tour the picturesque village of *Cua Van Floating Village* by local rowing boat for one hour to get a closer look at this traditional way of life.
- **17:00** Back to the boat and refresh. Enjoy a drink during Happy Hour offer and take in the beautiful sunset.
- **17:30** Learn how to make fresh spring rolls with a *cooking demonstration* on the sundeck (if weather permits) or in the restaurant.
- **19:00** Enjoy a sumptuous set **dinner** in the restaurant.
- **20:30** Retire to your cabin for an early night or star-gaze from the sundeck.

DAY 2: HALONG BAY (B/L/D)

- **06:15** Rise with the sun and welcome the new day with a *Tai Chi lesson* on the sundeck.
- **07:00** Start the day with a hearty **breakfast** in the restaurant.
- **09:00** Explore *Tien Ong Cave* one of Halong Bay's less well-known treasures with its many timeless stalactites and stalagmites located amidst the pristine landscapes of Cai Tai Island.
- **11:00** Return to Bhaya Legend to refresh after the morning excursion.
- **12:15** Enjoy **lunch** as the Bhaya Legend cruises slowly past beautiful karst towers and toward the next attraction.
- **15:00** Take a swim or kayak around the *Ho Ba Ham Area*. Soaking in the incredibly pristine water of this lake, you can sense peaceful moments as time seems to stop. The beach is a hidden gem with the picturesque appearance of the tall sea-almond tree pair, especially during autumn.
- **17:00** Back to the boat just in time to catch the magical sunset while sipping a drink during Happy Hour promotion.
- **17:30** Join the exciting *Master Chef* "*Halong Bay Edition" Competition* on the sundeck (or in the restaurant). Try your hand at creating authentic Vietnamese dishes, with the winner of the competition awarded with surprising gifts.
- **19:00** A cozy **dinner** is served in the restaurant.

20:45 Nightfall over the bay. Free time to watch the stars, or retire to the comfort of your cabin for a good night sleep.

DAY 3: HA LONG BAY (B/L/D)

- **06:15** For early risers, this is the perfect time to commute with nature by trying a *Tai Chi lesson* on the deck.
- **07:00** Start the day with a hearty **breakfast** in the restaurant.
- **08:00** Explore *Trinh Nu Area* where you could visit the cave and swim/ kayak in the emerald water. Trinh Nu Cave is one of the finest sunlight-filled caves in Halong Bay covering an area of 2,000m2 with stunning stalactites and stalagmites. Take a swim or sunbathe on Trinh Nu Beach.
- **09:30** Back to the boat as the boat leisurely cruises toward Titov area.
- **10:00** Enjoy an excursion to *Titov Island* where you could leisurely swim/ sunbathe on the pristine beach. If you're into trekking, take a hike to the top of the mountain where you could get a panorama view of Halong Bay we promise it's going to be breathtaking.
- **12:15** Back to the boat for some refreshment then enjoy **lunch** in the restaurant.
- **15:00** Explore *Sung Sot Cave*, the largest cave inside Halong Bay with 10,000 square meters of space, holds thousands of stalactites and stalagmites and is threaded by a 500-meter paved passageway.
- **17:00** Return to Bhaya Legend and enjoy Happy Hour as the sun sets over the horizon.
- **17:30** Try your hand at a *fruit-carving demonstration* with our Chef in the restaurant.
- **19:30 Dinner** is served in the restaurant or on the sundeck (if weather permits).
- **20:45** Another memorable day comes to an end. Try squid fishing with our crew before retiring to your cabin for a restful night's sleep.

DAY 4: HA LONG BAY - HANOI (B/Br)

- **06:15** Start your last day on the bay with another *Tai Chi lesson* on the sundeck.
- **07:00 Light breakfast** is served.
- **07:30** Kayak around the *Luon Cave* and enjoy the scenery as you pass through the iconic karst towers of Halong Bay.
- **09:00 Brunch** is served onboard as Bhaya Legend leisurely cruises back to the harbor.
- **10:30** Say goodbye to your crew and disembark at *Bhaya Cruise Centre* with memories fit to last a lifetime of your Gulf of Tonkin journey!
