YOUR BUS TRIP TO THE UNESCO HERITAGE SITE:


Departs from the centre of Hanoi to **Bhaya Cruise Centre** (located within Tuan Chau International Marina, Halong City)

Located in the Gulf of Tonkin, within Quang Ninh Province, in the northeast of Vietnam, the destination has been designated as a UNESCO World Heritage Site since 1994.
